## MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> AUGUST 2021 AT THE ARK AT 7:30PM.

- 82 <u>Public Participation</u> A member of the Speed Watch Team asked when the Cluster SID can be expected to be repaired and returned to full use. The Clerk advised that Worth Parish Council are currently working with the insurance company and the makers of the SID to get it repaired and she does not have a date when it will be back to working order.

The same gentleman asked with regard to the removal of the safety barrier on East Street. The Chairman advised WSCC are not planning on replacing the barrier because it is constantly being hit by large lorries, however, as a Member of WSCC he also advised that he had written to the Area Manager of Highways at WSCC and had copied in the Cabinet Member for Highways.
