



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Balcombe Road and Turners Hill Road, Crawley, 25th July 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Balcombe Road and Turners Hill Road, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Balcombe Road for a distance approx 644 metres

The emergency temporary closure commenced on 25th July 2022 for a maximum of 21 days. It is anticipated that works will be completed on 29th August 2022. The road closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while SGN undertakes 24hr Road Closure on Balcombe Road between the junctions of Turners Hill Road and Copthorne Road 25/07 - 26/08

24hr Road Closure on Turners Hill Road between Newbury Road and Old Hollow - 08/08 - 29/08

This is a rolling road closure starting on Balcombe Road and moving onto Turners Hill once works are complete. They will not be closed at the same time. This is for SGN to undertake gas mains replacement

The restriction will be in place **24hrs**
