#### A few examples:

- ✓ Small kitchen appliances
- ✓ Cables, plugs, chargers and controls
- ✓ Mobile phones and games consoles
- ✓ Power tools
- ✓ Batteries (in a separate bag)
- ✓ Personal grooming products

#### A few examples:



- X Bulky electricals
- **✗** Lightbulbs
- ✗ Microwave ovens
- ✗ TV's, laptops and monitors
- ✗ Gas cylinders from styling equipment
  - ✗ Black sacks

### Remove any batteries and place in a separate bag

- Bag it Place dry electricals in a carrier size bag (35 x 40 cm).
- Tie it Knot the bag securely so the contents can't fall out.
- **Recycle it!** Place the bag beside your rubbish bin for collection.

**IMPORTANT:** Place all unwanted household batteries in a separate bag. They will be collected with your other electrical recycling.
