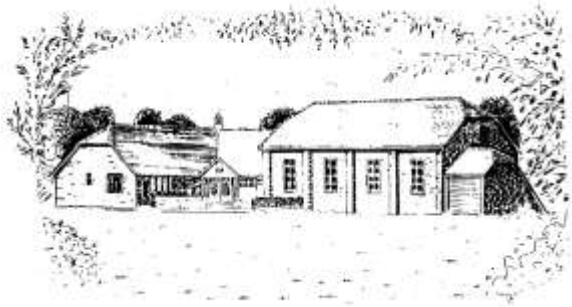

8 West Sussex County Council – Proposed Traffic Regulation Order (Ref: MDS8016-MM)

To consider the consultation from West Sussex County Council Highways regarding proposed changes to speed limits on Turners Hill Road and surrounding roads, and to agree the Parish Council's response before the consultation deadline of **9 July 2026**.

Proposed changes include:

- Extension of the existing 30 mph speed limit on Turners Hill Road eastwards to a point 475 metres east of the junction with Old Hollow.
 - Introduction of a 40 mph speed limit from the end of the extended 30 mph section eastwards to the existing 30 mph limit at Turners Hill.
 - Introduction of a 30 mph speed limit on Old Hollow for 175 metres north of Turners Hill Road.
 - Introduction of a 40 mph speed limit on Wallage Lane for 60 metres north-east of Turners Hill Road.
- 9 To discuss the Council's position regarding Withypitts Pond following Paddockhurst Estate's decision not to include the pond within its proposed grant application or to participate in the application process, and to consider the Council's options for securing funding and managing the pond.
