055 Correspondence

The Horsted Keynes Neighbourhood Plan has now been adopted.

The London to Brighton Bike Ride takes place on Sunday 18th June, and disruption is expected in the Village.

The annual Public Rights of Way report has been received for Turners Hill. No works are planned, and there is still a vacancy for a Local Access Ranger for the area. WSCC are encouraging Parish Councils to use their powers to make improvements to the Rights of Way network in their areas.

A resident of Willow Ridge has been denied an extended dropped kerb access to his house. He needs this for accessibility reasons and is hoping the Parish Council will be able to send a letter of support to WSCC to encourage them to reconsider their decision. This will be added to the July agenda.

WSCC has requested permission to put a sign on a street light on Church Road, warning of access to the Fire Station. This will be added to the July agenda.

The Air Ambulance Charity passed on their thanks for the £54 of donations raised at the Annual Parish Meeting.
