1. Quote from Roman Heating

The quote was noted for £487 to repair the combustion seals to each boiler. This was in addition to the scheduled servicing at £300.

4. Updates

a. The application for section 106 funds for the proposed new floor in the Dunlop Hall has been sent to Mid Sussex District Council and is awaiting approval. New quotes were sought and provided by the contractor.

b. Some of the light bulbs have failed in the Dunlop Hall, an electrician has been out to inspect, and we are awaiting a quote, including hire of a tower to access the ceiling.

c. CCTV/door entry system

A contractor has been booked in to service the CCTV and door entry system and replace the door magnet switch with a different type to suit the usage.

d. Baby Changing Unit Installation and Changing Room Modifications

The baby changing unit has been purchased but has not yet been installed. CJ

recommended that the unit be installed in the male changing room, positioned above one of the benches. Additionally, CJ proposed that the male changing room be redesignated simply as a "changing room." This includes replacing the current door lock with a toilet-style lock and updating the signage to indicate vacancy status.

The committee approved this recommendation. It was also noted that the two existing toilet facilities, being individual enclosed rooms, will be reclassified as unisex toilets.
